Some items may be too costly to handle. Others, in accordance with State and Federal regulations, have been deemed unsafe for resale.

- Air conditioners
- Automobile or truck parts, oil, tires, gasoline, fluid, etc.
- Bathroom fixtures (*sinks, tubs, toilets, etc.*)
- Bed frames (*metal "Hollywood"*)
- Blinds
- Bowling balls with or without bags
- Building materials (*concrete, bricks, stones, scrap iron, etc.*)
- Crib bumpers (*padded, pillow-like bumpers*)
- Encyclopedias
- Firearms and ammunition (*we do accept antiques with Manager approval*)
- Food and beverages
- Furniture that is stained, damaged, wet, torn, disassembled, or in need of reupholstering
- Gaspowered tools, including lawn mowers
- Large metal or wooden desks
- Hide-a-Beds
- Household chemicals
  - All aerosols
  - Anti-freeze, and fuel additives
  - Bleach or other household cleaners, liquids, or solids (*powders*)
  - Flammable liquids or solids
    - Including charcoal briquettes, sterno, propane tanks, etc.
  - Mercury-containing devices (*thermometers*)
  - Paint
  - Pesticides, fertilizer, rat poison – liquids and solids
- Household/yard debris
- Infant or child car seats, strollers, or cribs
- Large appliances (*refrigerators, stoves, washers, dryers, water heaters, etc.*)
- Large entertainment centers
- Large fitness equipment
- Light bulbs (*including fluorescent bulbs*)
- Light fixtures or ceiling fans with exposed wires
- Make-up, shampoos, conditioners, soaps, body washes, lotions, nail polish, perfumes, or body sprays
- Mattresses or box springs
- Medications – prescription or over-the-counter
- Metal file cabinets
- Pianos or organs
- Playground swing sets
- Smoke detectors
- Walkers, shower chairs with or without commode, or motorized scooters
